

Florida: 2 CEU's or more in: Public Health, Fumigation, Core, General Household Pests, Ornamental & Turf, and Termite.

Alabama:

Wednesday 10 points in Public Health (PH), Fumigation (FC, FB, ACF), Ornamental & Turf (OTPS, OTPC), Right-of-Way (ROW), demonstration, research and regulatory

Field Day & Workshop (Thurs-, Friday) 10 points in Ornamental & Turf (OTPS, OTPC). Wood Destroying Organisms (WDO, WDS), Household Pest Control (HPC, HPB), Industrial, Institutional & Health (IIHC), demonstration, research and regulatory.

Georgia:

Structural Pest Control: 2 Fumigation, up to 7 HPC, up to 4 WDO.

Pesticide Division. Up to 5 h in category 24, 27, 31, 35, 38, or 41.

Louisiana: Approved for recertification of Licensees and Technicians in categories of General Pest Control, Commercial Vertebrate and Termite control.

Mississippi: Approved for recertification in categories III, VII(A, B), VIII, and X.

North Carolina:

Structural Pest Control Commission. Up to 8 CEU's in P, 3 in W, 2 in F, and 4 in G.

Pesticide Division: 2 in L

South Carolina: Up to 1 CCU in Core, 4 in category 3, 8 in cat 7A, 5 in cat 8, and 2 in cat. 7B.

Tennessee: Up to 9 points in CO3 (O&T), up to 13 pt in CO7 (SPC) and CO8 (Public Health).

Virginia: Recertification in 1C, 3A-B, 7A, 7B, 7C.
